COVID19 – Update

Following the Prime Minister's address to the nation on 10th May 2020 and the recently published government Recovery Strategy, I am writing to inform you that the Sixth Form will remain closed for the foreseeable future. I can also confirm that the end of year summer exams will be completed at home as previously advised. Further details about exam arrangements will be sent to students at the beginning of next week. Students have already received a list of topics that will be examined and home learning not related to exam preparation has been suspended. Students must be using this time to thoroughly prepare for their end of year examinations and should have a revision timetable in place.

All lessons will continue to be delivered remotely and students must attend every day and ensure they are punctual to all lessons and intervention sessions. Ms Macdonald, our Attendance Officer will phone home where a student is absent and parents/guardians must inform us via email (enquiries@ncs6.org) if their child is absent.

I will await further information and guidance from the government about their intentions to re-open Sixth Forms/Colleges before the summer break and write to you once again with an update.
